

Throughout the spells alliteration is used, which is the repetition of the same or similar sounds at the beginning of words, e.g. 'Fern's first form is furled'. You'll also see the acrostic technique in every spell, where the first letters of each line spell out the Lost Words, e.g. F E R N. Close your eyes and think of your favourite part of the natural world around you. It could be a flower, bird, creature, tree – anything you choose.


